I was at the front desk on the night of Thursday October 26th when he checked in just before 7. That's the cut-off time for the night. If they come in later they're turned away.

I assume he was there the entire evening. Even though Alex likes to stir things up, he's smart and knows if he gets caught sneaking out he'll get kicked out. Having a bed at night is a pretty good motivator for these guys.

I'm not exactly sure what it means. But it was hard to forget. I'm pretty sure it's Shakespeare.

It caused quite a stir, because it was so weird. I took the bottle, (which was empty) and reminded him that we don't drink at the shelter.

I asked him where he'd gotten the bottle because it looked really expensive and I knew he didn't have that kind of money. He said it was a lovely parting gift from his good friend Max.

I read about that dean at the school who was murdered. I sure hope Alex didn't have anything to do with it.

**Detective:** Please state your full name for the record.

**Alex Jameson:** Alexander Bartholomew Jameson.

**Detective:** How did you know Max Cahill?

**Alex Jameson:** We were college roommates before that little snitch decided to ruin my life.

**Detective:** Excuse me?

**Alex Jameson:** Back in college I smoked some weed and kept it stashed under my bed. Max ratted me out. So they kicked me to the curb, which was just what he wanted.

**Detective:** Why do you say that?

**Alex Jameson:** Max and I received a lot of attention because we were the two boy wonders of Northup. The two local boys who were both college freshmen at the ripe age of 15. My intellect was far superior. Anyway, he wanted the attention all to himself, so the little bastard set his sights on procuring me a one-way ticket to Dante's Inferno.

**Detective:** Sounds like you bought and paid for that ticket all by yourself there Alex.

**Alex Jameson:** Everything would've been fine if he'd kept his nose in his books and out of my business!

**Detective:** So, you're still harboring resentment for all of this, I take it?

**Alex Jameson:** Kudos for figuring that out, Detective. Who wouldn't hold a grudge? I ended up a homeless drunk, while he lives the high life. All because he wouldn't keep his mouth shut. I should've shut it for him a long time ago.

**Detective:** Shut it for him how?

**Alex Jameson:** Don't even go there, I wasn't suggesting that I'd do him in.

**Detective:** I see here you've accomplished a lot with that superior intellect of yours: three arrests for DUI; one for assault and battery; two for breaking and entering; one for domestic abuse with a restraining order; and another one for selling drugs.

**Alex Jameson:** And I've got Max to thank for all of it.

**Detective:** Taking responsibility for your own actions ever occur to you?

**Alex Jameson:** Hey, he pushed me off the cliff. Gravity did the rest.

**Detective:** Uh-huh... I see here that you visited Max a couple of times recently at his office. About a week ago you barged in, clearly drunk, and said, I'm gonna read this off the statement, "Hey old buddy, remember me? The one you threw under the bus? Doing pretty well for yourself, huh? You better watch it 'cause I learned a thing or two in the slammer about how to deal with a snitch." Sound familiar?

**Alex Jameson:** Don't remember.

**Detective:** And on your second visit, the day Max was murdered, it sounds like you were actually quite well-mannered... at first. At least until you asked for money and he wouldn't give you any. I understand you smashed up a bunch of his expensive liquor bottles and then said something like, "You're gonna pay for what you've done!" Suppose you don't remember any of that either?

**Alex Jameson:** Nope. None of it.

**Detective:** Let's try your memory again, shall we? I hear third time's always a charm... Alex, where were you between 8:00 and 8:30 Thursday night?

**Alex Jameson:** Now that... I remember. I was over at that ultra-posh establishment over on 4th Street. Perhaps you've heard of it? The James P. Laramie Homeless Shelter. I call it "Jimmy P's."

**Detective:** Did anyone see you there around that time?

**Alex Jameson:** Well let's see... yes. Several other drunk homeless guys, who'd never admit to seeing me there because the last thing they want to do is talk to the cops. But you could probably talk with Raheesha over there. She's the only person in that whole place you can actually trust.

**Detective:** Okay so you've harbored resentment against Max for ages; you blamed him for basically all your problems; you recently showed up out of the blue, twice, at his office, and made threats, along with having a violent outburst. You've got no real alibi for the time of the murder, and then, lo and behold, he ends up dead. You're a smart guy, Alex, how would you say this makes you look?

**Alex Jameson:** I'm done with this conversation.

**Detective:** I'll have one of my men drive you back to the shelter and alert the staff to keep a close eye on you. Don't even think about leaving town, do you understand?

**Alex Jameson:** Sure thing, Sherlock.

**Detective:** You're a person of interest in an active murder investigation and if I find out you even walked past the bus depot I'll have someone bring you in. Am I making myself clear?

**Alex Jameson:** Crystal.

**Detective:** I'm done with this conversation. Get out of here.
