

OPERATION: SEAFIRE

Opening Credits

Scene 1 Inside house

Pete packing lunch, wife eating breakfast

PETE: I'm leaving for work early tonight; I've been given a new job.

WIFE: Oh really? What are you doing?

PETE: Oh, I'm just checking the radiation level to see that it doesn't get too high.

WIFE: Why don't you check your own blood pressure? - To see that it doesn't get too high!

PETE: What are you taling about?

WIFE: Admit it; you've been having an affair with your best friend's wife!

PETE: You're crazy. You know I've never been unfaithful to you. I'm going to get my jacket then I'm leaving.

(Pete leaves room and wife poisons his coffee thermos. Pete comes back in the room.)

PETE: I'm leaving now, goodbye

Scene 2. Pete arrives at work.

PETE: Hey, Frank, you've been transferred here too, eh?

FRANK: Yeh, I guess they couldn't break up a team.

PETE: Yea. What are you supposed to do?

FRANK: I'm in charge of launching the missiles if they have to be. And I also look after all electronics, etc. etc.

PETE: In other words, you're a computer technician.

FRANK: Yea, well, I guess that's another way of saying it.

(Frank leaves room. Pete sits down by console and reads the paper. A few minutes later, Pete drinks the coffee and chokes to death. Close up shot of warning buzzer. Medium shot of wall exploding.)

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Scene 3. Frank and J.D. sitting at control console.

FRANK: J.D., did you hear something?

J.D. Yeah, it must have been pretty loud! These walls are soundproof.

FRANK: I think it came from where Pete was working.

J.D. I'll go check it out.

(J.D. leaves the room and comes back a few minutes later with his back on fire.)

FRANK: Get down!

(J.D. jumps on control panel. Long shot of missile going off)

*1 Done* Scene 4. Medium shot of man sitting at his desk reading some papers; phone rings; man picks it up.

Man: Yeah, what is it? (Pause) Ohm my God!

(Man hangs up phone. Dials another number.)

I'm calling an emergency conference in five minutes! Get everyone there.

Scene 5. Shot of people sitting in conference room.

Delegate #1

You had better have a good reason for calling us out here at this time of night.

Man: I assure you, I do.

Del. #2. All right, let's have it.

Man: Project Omega is now in effect.

All Dels. What!

(Chatter can be heard throughout the room.)

Del.#3 (Standing up) What kind of operation are you running! This means World War III.

Man: I am aware of that. I am also aware that World War III means the end of the world!

Del.#4 And just what are you going to do about it?

Man: That, ladies and gentlemen, is what we are here to decide.

Del.#5 Well, why don't we just use the alert system?

Man: That, Sir, is a very good idea; only there is one problem. There isn't one. We felt that since the missiles would only be used in case of attack we didn't put in an alert system.

Del. #6 (Jumping up) What are you? Some kind of nut? Every atomic warhead should have an alert system; that is common sense.

Man: If you will remember, ladies and gentlemen, we all passed a bill that we were not going to have an alert system!

(Delegate #6 sits down)

Del.#7 Why don't we just send up other missiles to intercept Project Omega.

Man: That is exactly what I had in mind.

Del. #8 And just where in mind did you plan on getting these missiles of yours? Russia?

Man: As a matter of fact, yes. (Fade out, fade in)  
Now are we all in agreement?



Scene-6 Russian and American talking on phone, talking drowned out by music - only 30 seconds.

Scene 7 Russian jet intercepts missile. Missile hits American city. More Russian, Japanese interceptions

Scene 8

President: Alright. The Russian and Japanese fighters have destroyed all the missiles so what is the problem?

Man: Well, you see, Mr. President, there are two more missiles. 1 heading for Tokyo, the other heading straight for the center of the earth. Once it gets there, it will explode and take the earth with it. But we will be <sup>only be able to divert</sup> ~~able to divert~~ either one of them. The only problem is .....

*Done* Scene 9 In a control room, two technicians at a control console.

Tec. #1 I did it!

Tec. #2 Did what?

Tec. #1 I programmed the missile headed for Tokyo to go five miles away into the ocean!

Tec. #2 Great, now the missile will explode in the ocean; creat a tidal wave and sink the whole island!

Tec. #1 Shit!

(Scenes of massive destruction in Japan and finally sinking into the ocean.

Then shots of the missiles flying into the center of the earth, and earthquake and finally shots of the world blowing up.)
